Minutes for meeting #16
Tuesday, May 12, 2020 at 6:00 PM

There were 6 people (total) in attendance= Commissioner Bill Bullock (guest) and 6 of 9 committee members: Michael Gebhardt (Chair), Frank Jarvenpaa, Jon Milligan, Sanford Langager, Chris White and Steve Keebler.

1. The east ditch will not be redone in time for Memorial Day, partly because of a long lead time for concrete siphons. The project will be put out to bid and it is expected to be completed this year.
2. There is some concern by Chris DeVries that damage was done to water shutoff valves. MDT stated to that if it happened during construction, they'll fix it.
3. The walk-thru with MDT will occur after chip, seal, and paint. The walk-thru will include Commissioner Bullock, Chris DeVries, and Sanford Langager as the representative from RISC. RISC members will perform our own walk-thru to collect a punch list of construction issues. We shall also attempt to identify sections of the west ditch (and other project aspects) where the as-built is grossly different from the as-designed. This walk-thru is to be scheduled soon, perhaps Friday or Saturday.
4. Bill Felton is being replaced by Shawn Samson (name?).
5. There is no 70 to 35 transition yet but there will be prior to the traffic study.
6. Jon Milligan expressed concern that Cooney Rd has a downslope into the highway which could result in t-bone accidents when it is icy.

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
